## **QUALITY**

cooking type B, very good taste, no discoloration after cooking, starch content 12 - 13 %

### **YIELD**

high (with high marketable yield at early harvesting), uniform calibration, medium number of tubers (reacts positively to foliar fertilization with phosphate)

### **TUBER**

oval, shallow eyes, smooth, bright skin, yellow flesh

### **PLANT**

erect stem type, white flowering, rapid emergence and foliage development

### **PLANTING**

relatively good dormancy, therefore pre-germinate carefully, suitable for all types of soil, treatment against Rhizoctonia is recommended, distance in row 34 cm (for early potatoes) normal cultivation 30 - 32 cm, plant 2 cm deeper than normal

# **FERTILIZATION**

N-Fertilization: 160 kg N/ha

(incl. N-min und N-org)

**P-Fertilization:** 60 - 80 kg/ha **K-Fertilization:** min. 250 kg/ha

**Mg-Fertilization:** 60 kg/ha

Foliar fertilization with trace elements and phosphate recommended

### **PLANT PROTECTION**

no known metribuzin intolerance; also use active substances against Alternaria in normal spraying sequences against Phytophthora

# **HARVEST**

ripens early and can be harvested after 90 - 100 days, goes well from the haulm during green harvesting, but care must be taken to harvest gently

### **IRRIGATION**

desirable for uniform growth in dry periods, stop irrigation 2 weeks before haulm regulation to achieve higher starch content and facilitate haulm regulation

#### **STORAGE**

stores well
